



- The customer must have an Energy Audit performed **PRIOR** to the installation of a Home Improvement
 - Home Improvements completed before the Energy Audit will be denied
- The customer must provide a finalized invoice that includes:
 - Date of installation
 - Details a zero balance due
 - Details of the qualified Home Improvement
- Windows
 - The customer must have a primary electric heating source **OR** central air conditioning
 - Window air conditioners do not qualify as “central air conditioning”
 - The invoice must detail the qualifying U-Factor
- Rebates are processed 6-8 weeks after all required documents are submitted and approved.
 - Delays will occur should the required documents not be submitted
 - Lack of required documents will suspend rebates from being processed

Step 1: Get a Home Energy Audit!

Start by scheduling an audit. An energy expert* will come to your home and work with you, to identify specific energy-saving improvement opportunities. For \$100, the energy expert will:

- Evaluate your home’s heating and cooling system insulation, windows, doors, appliances and lighting
- Conduct a blower door test to detect air leaks that could be costing you money
- Install energy-saving products, at no additional cost** to you, such as:
 - Compact fluorescent light (CFL) bulbs
 - Kitchen and bathroom faucet aerators
 - Low flow showerheads
 - Water heater pipe insulation
